

## Curriculum vitae

Your curriculum vitae is an important part of your application. It should give a brief and concise outline of your academic and professional experience, as well as any information relevant to your research project, in tabular form.

Format and length: PDF format (1-3 pages, A4)

The applicant is responsible for format and layout. Usually, an academic curriculum vitae provides the following information:

- Education and academic career in reverse chronological order; title of qualifying paper(s), supervision and grading
- Relevant professional experience
- Language skills incl. level
- Skills and competences relevant for the research project
- Academic achievements (publications, grants, awards, participation in conferences, etc.)
- Min. 2 references incl. academic affiliation and eMail contact
